PRETORIA



1 NIGHT

06.09. - 07.09.2026

DISTANCE (nonstop): ca. 58 km (ca. 40 minutes)

Pretoria is one of South Africa's three capital cities, based in the province of Gauteng. 50km north of Johannesburg, Pretoria represents a more laidback lifestyle of the urban surroundings but still serves as an important economic centre. It is a charming, quiet city known as the Jacaranda City for all the purple blossom-bedecked trees lining its thoroughfares. While in the city, be sure to visit the Pretoria Botanical Gardens and the many museums and galleries. Outdoor activities include the Wonderboom and Groenkloof Nature Reserve, the Bird Sanctuary, and a steam train ride around Pretoria.

Morning and evening game drives bring close contact with the fascinating wildlife, resulting in a unique nature experience every time.

Hiking trails, cultural centres, 4x4 trails and stunning restaurants are a few of the many things to do here. The incredible unspoilt wilderness areas that seamlessly contrast with sophisticated resorts draw people in time and time again.

BLYDE RIVER CANYON

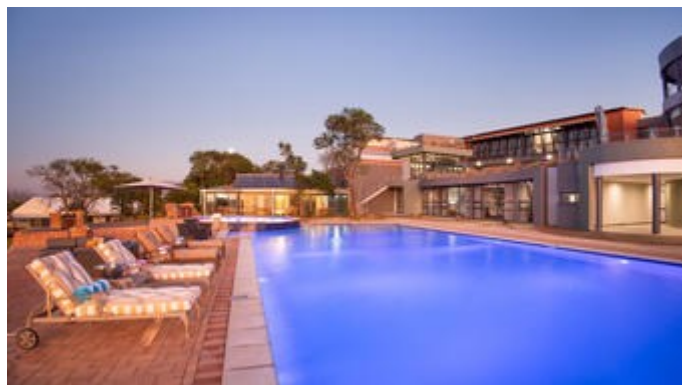

20.09. - 21.09.2026

DISTANCE (nonstop): ca. 391 km (ca. 4 hours, 54 minutes)

Surrounded by Bluegum and Wattle trees and lying close to the Swaziland border, Mpumalanga's pretty town of Piet Retief is known primarily for its spectacular and prolific birdlife and features several ideal birdwatching locations as well as a fantastic bird sanctuary. Several beautiful trails wind among wetlands, rivers and mountains, offering visitors wonderful opportunities for hiking, horseriding and fishing among exquisite flora and fauna. The town's history can be discovered at the informative library and information centre, and a collection of striking war memorials and monuments, which honour Zulu, British, and other people who lost their lives to war. Make sure to see the delightful and unusual collection at the Candle Factory. Piet Retief also functions as a relaxing stop on the way to Pongola and the North Coast beaches of KwaZulu-Natal.

DUSK TO DAWN FARM GUESTHOUSE (B&B)

6 NIGHTS

21.09. - 27.09.2026

DISTANCE (nonstop): ca. 0 km (ca.)

On the northeast corner of South Africa, the Zimanga Private Game Reserve protects a pristine area perfect for wildlife photography. Guests at Zimbanga are assured an authentic wildlife experience that is not hurried or crowded as there are only three game vehicles in the 7000-hectare reserve. Overnight hide photography sessions are offered here. The new Tamboti Overnight Hide provides a six-night package for an excellent wildlife photographic getaway.
